Wedding Guidance

COVID-19 RULES AND REGULATIONS

We would really appreciate your support at this time, so we kindly ask that you read this guidance in advance and share it with you guests before your Wedding here at Forbes of Kingennie Country Resort.

Guidance for wedding ceremonies and receptions should be followed during these elements of the function. This includes physical distancing between household groups. 2 metre physical distancing, is the default in all settings, and should be maintained within the venue. However, the 1 metre physical distancing exemption applies to the contained hospitality areas of the premises. Clear signage will be present to indicate that guests are entering the 1 metre zone.

Please do not come to the Resort on the day if you have any symptoms including; a high temperature, a new continuous cough or a loss of taste/smell. Likewise if you have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive with COVID-19 we ask that you do not attend.

We have a track and trace system in place. One member from each household must sign in (your details will be stored securely for 21 days and then destroyed).

We ask that guests wear face coverings other than when eating and drinking. The use of face coverings is mandatory in indoor premises. This includes in those areas of the venue (such as the reception, toilets or other corridor/circulation spaces) that are not used for eating and drinking.

Hand sanitising stations will be available throughout the resort, we ask for this to be used upon entering and exiting the building.

Singing and raised voices should be avoided, and music should be limited to instruments that do not require to be blown into. If you would like a Piper to attend your Wedding we ask that they remain outside at all times and are physically distanced from your guests.

No music, singing, dancing or shouting is permitted at present. This is consistent with the measures brought in by the Scottish Government on 14 August which are part of statutory guidance.

Guests should be seated by household and seating may be for up to a maximum of 6 persons per table. There should be no more than 2 households per table and distancing measures should be applied between each household seated at the same table, in accordance with the Hospitality guidance issued by the Scottish Government. There should be no mixing between tables.

The distance between table should be in accordance with the Scottish hospitality guidelines - Guests should be seated at all times, other than when entering/exiting premises or using toilet facilities. Guests should wear face coverings, other than when eating and drinking.

In addition to licensing requirements we are permitted to close at 10pm. Last drinks orders will be at 9.30pm. Table service is required at all times so we kindly ask that you stay seated.
